Oskaloosa Elementary follows the Positive Behavior Support

System which is composed of 5 areas:

Communication-Respect-Responsibility-Engagement-Empathy. Teachers have been teaching these skills and we're now ready to begin Tier II of the system. Students who have not mastered a specific concept will be referred to the coordinator who will place students, within grade levels, into the non-mastered skill group. It is our hope that students will only need 1 or 2 additional lessons in order to master the behavior. Students who do not master the Positive Behavior in Tier II will be referred to Tier III where they'll be given one-on-one instruction toward mastery.
